

## **NCGA's VeraSun Ad Hoc Advisory Committee Fact Sheet**

**Q: Who formed the VeraSun Ad Hoc Advisory Committee?**

A: NCGA, state affiliated organizations and others formed the VeraSun ad hoc advisory committee.

**Q: Why was the committee formed?**

A: The committee was formed to make certain that the views, expertise, and interests of corn growers in the VeraSun case were represented effectively before the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in Delaware and to VeraSun, and to help keep members of NCGA and state affiliates informed regarding the process and activities of VeraSun's situation.

**Q: Who serves corn growers on this committee?**

A: Six corn growers serve on this committee. NCGA Chairman Ron Litterer, Greene, Iowa; Dennis Boersen, Hudsonville, Mich.; Joseph Breker, Havana, N. D.; Greg Whitmore, Shelby, Neb.; Gene Baumgardner, Jeffersonville, Ohio; and Walt Bones, Parker, S. D.

**Q: Are there other roles that the committee members will play in the VeraSun case?**

A: The committee will serve as a communications channel through which growers can voice their concerns, needs, and other comments on this case.
