Get your Lawn Equipment in Tip-Top Shape for the Season.



Refresh Fuel

Before attempting to start your machine, make sure the fuel from last season has been drained and fresh fuel added.



Check Oil and Filters

This keeps your engine clean by preventing build-up of particles and foreign materials.



Inspect Blade

Safely remove the blade and replace it or bring it in to the local hardware store to have the blade sharpened. A sharp blade cuts effectively and puts less stress on your machine.



Check Spark Plugs

Replacing spark plugs periodically is a cheap way to keep your engine running smoothly.



Review Procedures

Refer to your user manual for your equipment's product details, maintenance and care schedule; tighten fasteners, nuts, bolts, straps or handles; ensure warning labels are visible.
